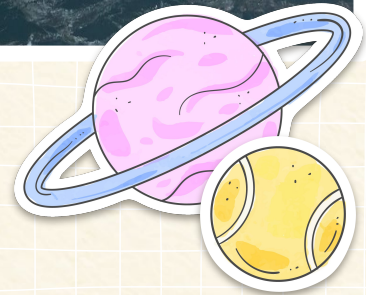
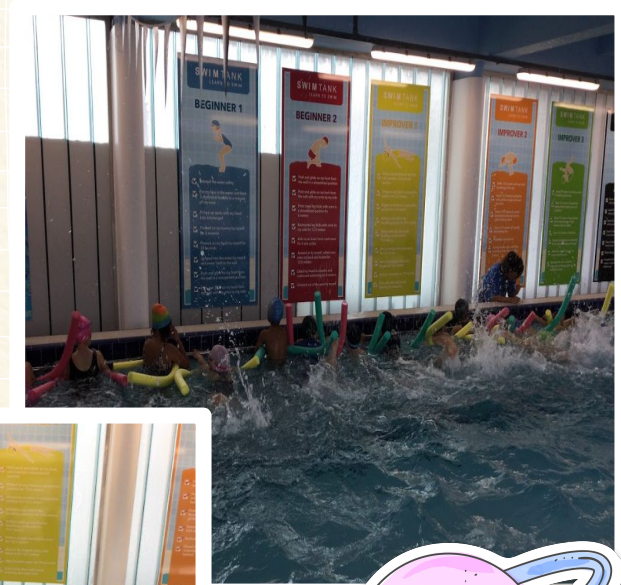


The reception children are settling into their new environment. The children are making new friendships, following routines and listening to adults.





Swimming is back on our curriculum!



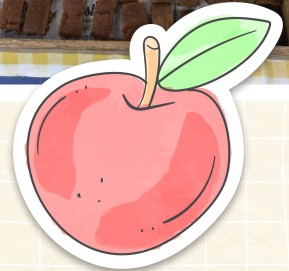


Year 2 did not let the rain stop them learning and enjoying their visit to Kew Gardens

I hope that your students and staff are enjoying Olive Dining so far.

Now that the team are settled, we would be delighted to introduce **Olio** into your School.

As you may be aware, Olio is a Food Waste company, designed to facilitate collections from businesses which have surplus food (fresh, cold, hot, and frozen).

At Olive Dining, we strive to have no waste, or as little waste as possible, however, occasionally this occurs - predominantly on Fridays. This is when our team would alert an Olio volunteer to come and collect any leftover food.

There is no impact to the School in terms of disruption or financial cost and our team liaise directly with the Olio volunteer.

We are proud to say our Schools collectively have had a big impact in the time we have been in partnership with Olio, and I attached a breakdown from last year for you to view.

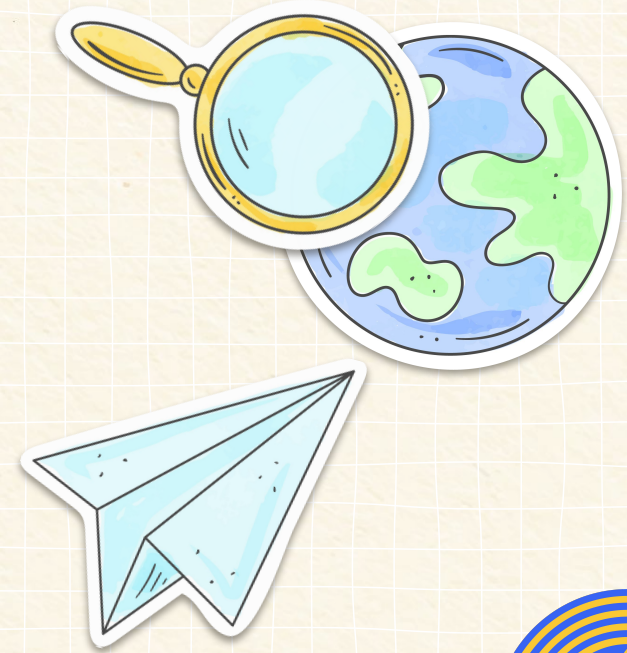

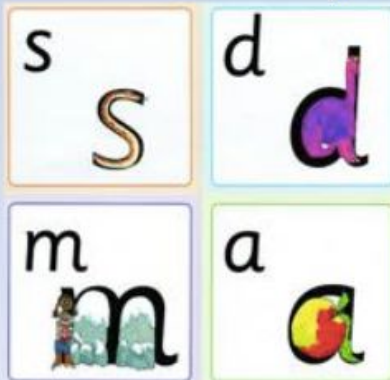

WHO

Finchley Foodbank is here to support residents in the London Borough of Barnet who are experiencing food poverty. You DO NOT need to have a voucher/referral. You DO need to bring a letter/bill/statement with your name and address on it, dated within the last 3 months and evidence of any children living with you.

Each household can visit ONCE every 2 weeks. If needed, new clients can visit weekly for up to 8 weeks and then once every 2 weeks. We ask that you visit us only when you are experiencing food poverty.
