Computing	Use of everyday technology in role play settings - vets, police station, school and doctor's surgery
Expressive Art & Design	Explore different materials freely, to develop their ideas about how to use them and what to make. Create and make use of props and materials when role playing characters in familiar narratives and stories.
Physical Education	Develop overall body strength, coordination, balance and agility through gross motor skills activities.  Continue to develop the use of the tripod pencil grip to develop a fast and accurate handwriting style.
