
















Our Year 3 Curriculum - Summer 1

Big Question 	Civilisation: Were the Pyramids the greatest achievement of the Ancient Egyptians?
Maths 	In maths this term we will continue to look at division and multiplication but diving deeper with our understanding. We will be looking at remainders and multiplying 2 digit numbers by a one-digit number, and then they will use this information to help them problem solve.
English 	We will be reading and working on a variety of texts this term in our English lessons, focusing on traditional tales with a twist. We will be incorporating daily spelling lessons into our timetable, and will be sending home words for the children to learn.
History 	We will be looking at what a civilization is, in relation to the Ancient Egyptians, inferring from sources to understand about daily life in Ancient Egypt. We will explore the lives of some of the most famous pharaohs, research why they built the pyramids and the role peasants played in their construction.
Science 	The topic for science this term is Animals including Humans. We will be looking and exploring different parts of our body, focusing on our muscles and our skeleton. We will also reflect on our nutrition (so looking at what we eat and how it affects us).
Religious Education 	Students will be exploring another of our communities religions this term. They will be introduced to the faith of Buddhism and learn of how Buddhists follow this religion.
PSHE 	What makes a community? We will be exploring what characteristics and features make a community, by looking at our local community and how it supports those that live within it.
Music 	This term Mrs Fewster and Mrs Apicella will be continuing to explore the structure of musical compositions with the children, specifically focusing on exploring different musical arrangements.
Computing 	In Computing we will be exploring how to collect and analyse data through the use of online surveys. Children will be creating their own surveys and have their peers complete them. They will then analyse the data to highlight trends.
French 	Bonjour tout le monde! This term in French we will be learning all about Les Animaux as well as trying to recall the French we have learnt so far this year. We will then move onto reading a story you are familiar with, but in French... Le Petit Chaperon Rouge!
PE 	In outdoor PE children will be learning the rules of Ultimate Frisbee, developing their passing and catching skills and understanding the role of defence. For those having indoor PE this term, we will be learning about Yoga.
Art Day 	We will be looking at the work of sculpture and artist Grayson Perry. He will learn about his process, how he works the clay to create different textures and images with the clay. He will use this to inspire our own clay creations.
D&T Day 	For our D&T day we will be exploring moving mechanisms including pivots and levers, looking carefully at the inputs and outputs involved, making prototypes and designing and finally making our own moving book!
