Subject	Title	Description
Reading	Ancient Greece ODYSEUS ODYSEUS	'Who Let the Gods Out' by Maz Evans. Destination Reader skills: Predicting, Making connections, asking questions, evaluating, inferring, summarising & clarifying.
Writing		The Adventures of Odysseus' by Hugh Lupton, Daniel Morden & Christina Balit. Retelling stories, writing descriptions, writing letters, writing diary entries, editing.
Maths	Place Value	Place value to 1,000, place value to 10,000, Roman Numerals, rounding to 10s, 100s and 1000s, negative numbers, times tables.
History	Ancient Greece	A study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.
Science	Animals, including humans	The digestive system and teeth functions, and food chains.
Art	Sculpture	Clay Pottery: Handles, base and spout.
R.E.	Judaism	What it means for an individual to belong to a faith. How religious identity is developed through dress and personal symbols. Similarities and differences in the ways in which faiths express and interpret these ideas.

PSHE	How do we treat each other with respect?	Respect and responsibilities linked to our class charters.
Music	Dragon Scales-Pentatonic scale	Sing independently and blend when singing in a large group and using pitch and expression.
