
















Our Year 5 Curriculum - Autumn 1



Subject	Title	Description
Reading	Holes 	'Holes' by Louis Sachar Destination Reader skills: Predicting, summarising, asking questions, evaluating, inferring, & clarifying.
Writing	One Thousand and One Arabian Nights Holes  	'One Thousand and One Arabian Nights' by Geraldine McCaughrean. Outcome: narrative based on the structure of Arabian Nights 'Holes' by Louis Sachar Outcome: negative review of Camp Green Lake
Maths	Place Value 	Place value to 10,000,, place value to 1,000,000, Roman Numerals, rounding to 10s, 100s and 1000s, negative numbers, times tables.
History	Early Islamic Civilisation 	A study of a non-European society which contrasts with British history. Children will study the city of Baghdad in 900 CE and discover the achievements of 'The Golden Age of Islam' which can be linked to life today.
Science	Earth and Space 	Children will investigate the movement of the Moon, Sun and Earth and how this leads to day and night.

Art	Drawing: Islamic 	Understand the purpose, features and history of Islamic art before applying their knowledge to use a range of materials to draw their own geometric designs.
R.E.	Islam 	To understand what it means for an individual to belong to a faith. To understand how religious identity is developed through dress and personal symbols. To understand the importance of the 5 Pillars.
